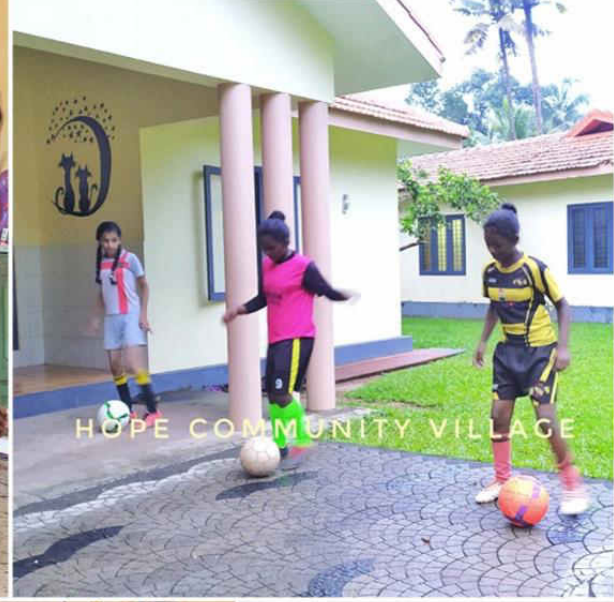

Our children participated in the **Child Rights Webinar** conducted by the DCPU and WCD. The questions raised by the children were answered by the District Collector and the District Judge.

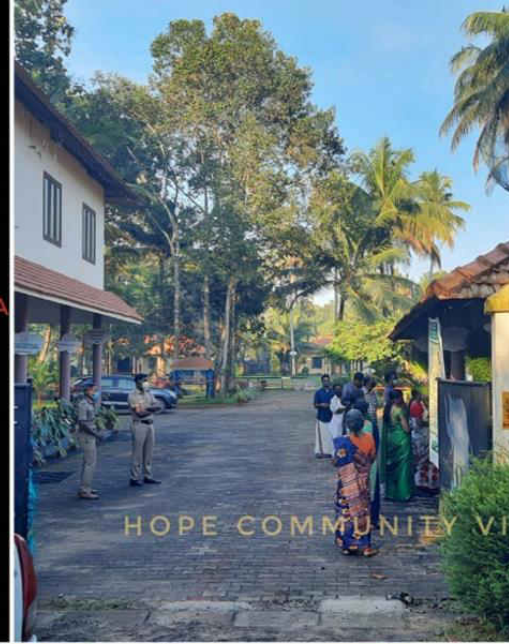

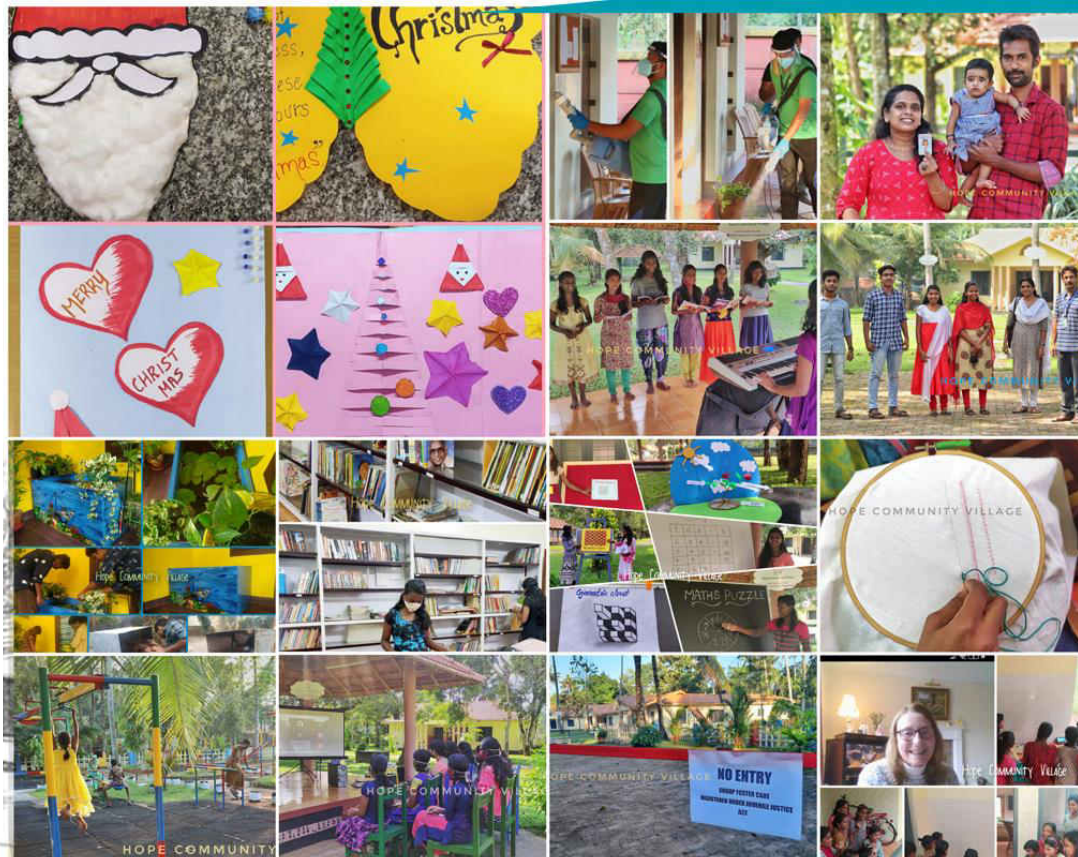

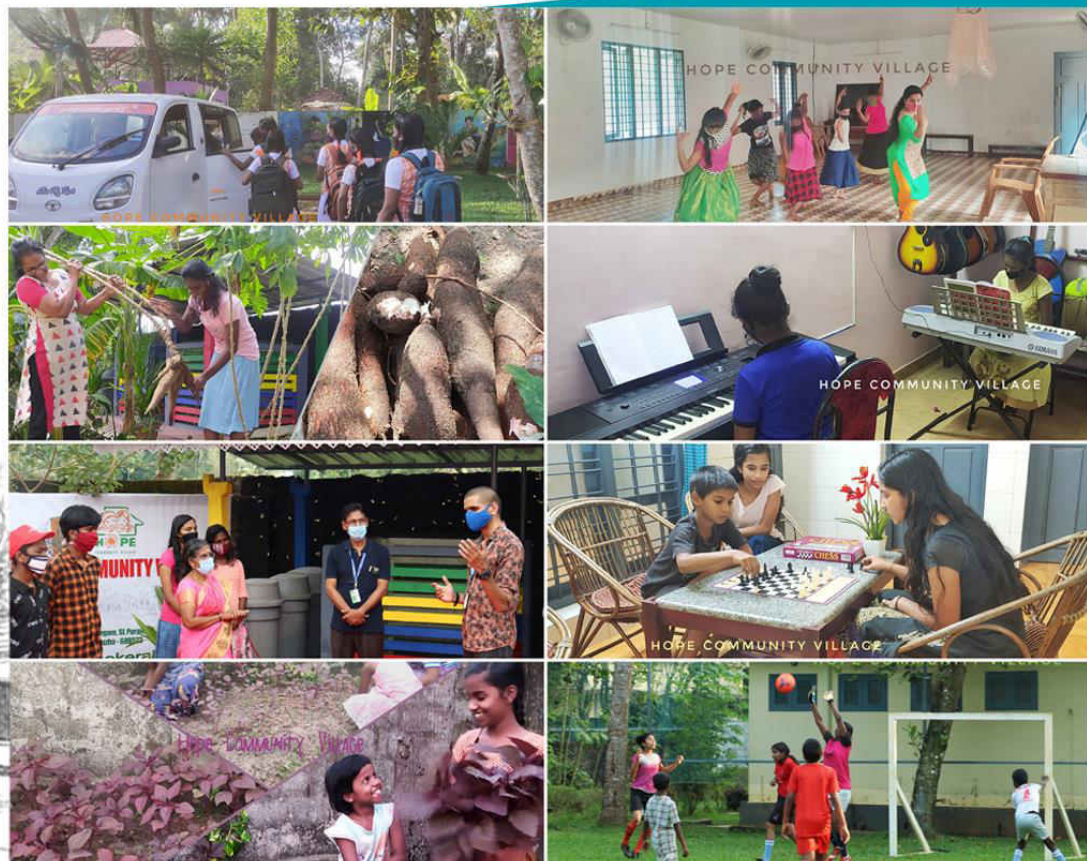
New Year 2021 Celebrations was colorful with New Year gifts and camp fire. The camp fire was a special event for our boys in the Hope Youth House.

Wall painting and re-use of old materials – The wall painting activities are conducted for the children in our reading corner. It was a best platform for them to show their drawing/painting skills. Our elder children also created some beautiful corners with the waste materials including tyres, cement etc.



Career guidance and career counselling was conducted for our children by the social workers in the month of March. It was a platform for our elder children to make a plan about their career.

With the help of your monthly regular support, Hope Community Village (www.hopekerala.org) take BIG strides in this area. We provide 18-21 years and 21-23 years (2 stages) of aftercare support to a child brought up in the Family Homes of Hope Community Village. For this all the possibilities are explored by our team for providing vocational/professional coursers to our youngsters.
